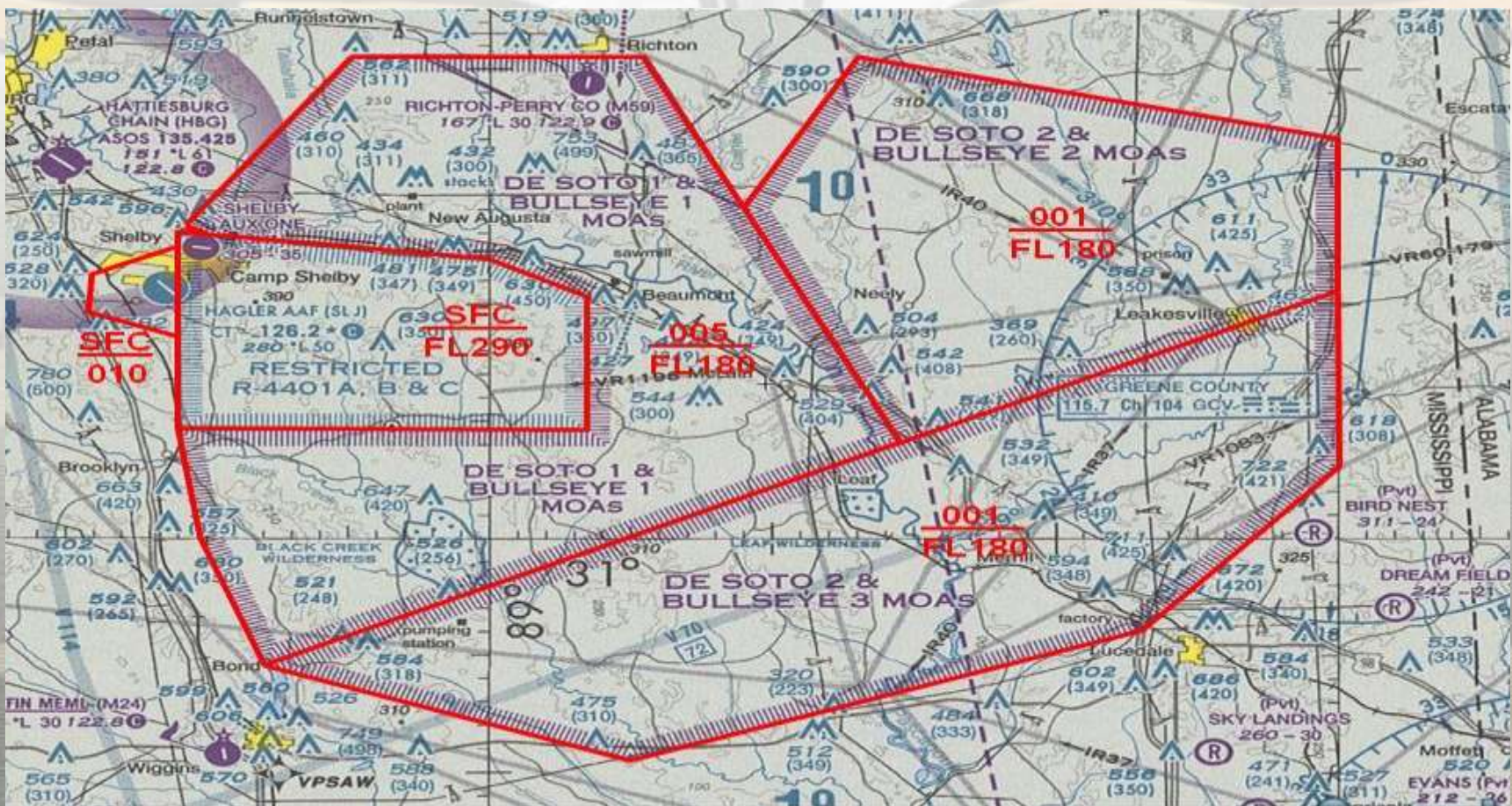


- 1,250' X 50' improved runway
